TRANSFER ARTICULATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN DECKER COLLEGE OF NURSING AND HEALTH SCIENCES AND SUNY BROOME COMMUNITY COLLEGE

Introduction

Based upon mutual respect for the integrity of parallel programs and in an effort to better serve students intending to pursue a bachelor's degree with a major in nursing, SUNY Broome Community College and Binghamton University Decker College of Nursing and Health Sciences hereby enter into this articulation agreement.

SUNY Broome Community College will direct prospective students to consult the <u>Decker College of Nursing and Health</u> <u>Sciences traditional transfer web page</u> and the <u>Binghamton University Bulletin</u> to review specific information about courses and admissions requirements.

Objectives

The objectives of this agreement are to:

- assist SUNY Broome students by providing a curriculum plan which meets all degree requirements for the SUNY Broome Community College associate degree in health studies and all prerequisite coursework needed to apply to Binghamton's traditional nursing program.
- facilitate the transition of graduates from SUNY Broome Community College to a baccalaureate degree program in Decker College of Nursing and Health Science at Binghamton University.
- attract qualified students to SUNY Broome Community College and Binghamton University.
- encourage academic coordination between the faculty and advisors at the two institutions, including curricular reviews.
- assess and exchange information on the specific outcomes of this articulation program with the goal of continual improvement.

Terms of Agreement

SUNY Broome Community College students who follow the advising guide and have the appropriate prerequisite coursework and satisfactory grades to apply for admission to the junior class of the Decker College of Nursing and Health Sciences traditional nursing program. This articulation agreement is not a guarantee of admission to prospective students who become applicants for the Decker College of Nursing and Health Sciences/Binghamton University. Admissions is competitive and limited due to space. Applicants are required to earn a 3.0 GPA, with preference given to those who have a B or better in prerequisite courses. Be advised that the mean GPA for accepted transfer students for the past five academic years has been a 3.5 GPA. Applicants should apply and submit all application materials by February 1, prior to the fall semester the student is interested in matriculating for optimal consideration.

Decker College Transfer Credit Policy & Guidelines

Transfer credit is evaluated by the <u>Decker Division of Advising and Academic Excellence</u>. To be considered for transfer, coursework must be transcripted through an accredited institution.:

- Coursework will be transferred for the same number of semester-hour credits that were awarded at the home
 institution. A course taken for 3 credits at SUNY Broome can transfer to Binghamton and fulfill degree
 requirements even if the course is offered at Binghamton for 4 credits.
- Decker College awards transfer credits upon receipt of official transcripts. Students are responsible for contacting the credit-granting institution for these transcripts.
- All nursing prerequisites for the Decker College of Nursing and Health Sciences require a minimum grade of C-.
- Prior to starting junior level nursing courses in the Decker College of Nursing and Health Sciences, admitted students must have all prerequisites completed. General education and elective coursework may be taken concurrently with nursing coursework, though students are encouraged to complete as much as possible prior to transfer.
- Admitted students who follow the provided advising guide may require additional coursework to complete degree requirements for the bachelor of science with a major in nursing.
